Public Housing Program Preference Information & Verification Forms

The City of Des Moines, Municipal Housing Agency has adopted the following preferences for ranking Public Housing applicants to prioritize selection for assistance. These preferences change the order of placement on the waiting list since selection will be based on need, in addition to the date the application was filed. This process will assist in targeting services to these applicants with the greatest need.

Public Housing applicants wishing to apply for a preference must print out the applicable Verification Form(s) below, complete the form, attach the required verification noted on the form and submit to the DMMHA Administrative Office. Applicants will be required to provide acceptable verification that they are eligible for a preference. Acceptable verification must come from a government agency, social service agency, law enforcement agency or employer. More information regarding acceptable verification is noted on each Verification Form. Adequacy of the verification shall be determined by the DMMHA in its sole discretion. The verification will be valid for ninety (90) days. If the applicant is not housed within ninety (90) days, the preference may be re-verified at the time the family is offered assistance.
