

## **What Goes in the Collection Carts?**

### **GARBAGE COLLECTION CART** [Garbage Guidelines](#)

#### Items to Include in the Garbage Collection Cart:

Garbage/trash in disposable plastic bags or boxes inside the cart

Styrofoam

Plastic bags

The following papers: tissues, napkins, toilet paper, and paper towels

Aluminum Foil

Lids from jars

Paper Contaminated with food

Containers that once held motor oil or antifreeze

#### Other Trash:

Extra Trash that is placed outside the green collection cart will be collected if they have the appropriate sticker.

Large items are items that do not fit in a 33 gallon bag or a 24x24x36 box and will be collected if they meet requirements and have the appropriate stickers attached to them.

### **RECYCLING COLLECTION CART** [Recycling Guidelines](#)

#### Items to Include in the Recycling Collection Cart:

Newspapers (including inserts)

Mixed Paper (including junk mail, phone books, and magazines)

Cardboard (broken down and cut to fit into the cart)

Plastic Containers (including bottles, yogurt or margarine tubs)

Glass Containers (all colors)

Tin/Aluminum Cans (no need to remove labels)

Wire Clothes Hangers

Empty Aerosol Cans

### **YARD WASTE** [Yard Waste Guidelines](#)

#### Yard Waste Containers:

"Compost it" Bag

Store-brand/generic paper yard waste bag with a "Compost it" sticker

Cardboard box (2x2x3 feet or smaller) with a "Compost it" sticker

Yard Waste must meet requirements

#### Yard Waste Items Collected:

Grass Clippings and Hedge Trimmings

Leaves

Flower and Garden Plantings

Brush and Branches

Twigs

Whole Christmas Trees (must have 1 "compost it!" sticker, all tinsel removed & not in plastic bag)
