### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on MacRae Park Trail Connection: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Miner Hardscape, Matt Miner, Owner, \$173,604.60.

## **SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the MacRae Park Trail Connection and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will provide a safer bicycle and pedestrian connection between MacRae Park and the American Discovery Trail.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$173,604.60 Construction Contract (\$200,000 City Engineer's Estimate).

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2015-2016 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Parks – 7, Multi-Use Trails, PK045, Being: \$173,604.60 in Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) Resource Enhancement And Protection (REAP) funding (\$300,000 max).

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:


On May 4, 2015, under Roll Call No. 15-0729, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the MacRae Park Trail Connection. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the MacRae Park Trail Connection, 11-2015-003. The improvement includes the construction of a 10-foot wide 6-inch thick Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) recreational trail, earthwork, clearing and grubbing, retaining wall, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plans File Nos. 568-177/197, along the west side of Bancroft Street, connecting MacRae Park to the American Discovery Trail, Des Moines, Iowa.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

Miner Hardscape, Granger, IA Kingston Services, LLC, West Des Moines, IA Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., Slater, IA Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Newton, IA T K Concrete Inc., Pella, IA Gruss Construction, LLC, Carlisle, IA, Bid not read

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on May 19, 2015.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Miner Hardscape, Matt Miner, Owner, 17981 Hwy 141, Granger, IA, 50109 in the amount of \$173,604.60, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
