AGENDA HEADING:

Authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary right-of-way and easements for the Hubbell Avenue and Easton Boulevard Traffic Signal Upgrade Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary right-of-way and easements for the Hubbell Avenue and Easton Boulevard Traffic Signal Upgrade Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain. This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate the right-of-way acquisition process under eminent domain. This project consists of upgrading the existing traffic signals at the intersection of Hubbell Avenue and Easton Boulevard.

FISCAL IMPACT:


Amount: \$2,000 total estimated right-of-way acquisition and closing costs.

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2015-16 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Street Improvements – 44, Traffic Signals, Channelization and School Crossings, TR091

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On July 24, 2006, by Roll Call No. 06-1472, the City Council authorized submittal of an application to the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) for Traffic Safety Funds in the amount of \$140,000 for traffic signal and sidewalk upgrades at the intersection of Hubbell Avenue and Easton Boulevard.

At this time, three (3) permanent easements for public pedestrian way and utilities are needed from three (3) adjoining property owners for this project, including Gerald C. and Melodee A. Nigon Revocable Family Living Trust at 2440 Hubbell Avenue, Stork Townsend, Inc. at 2425 Hubbell Avenue and Kartar Properties, LLC at 2501 Hubbell Avenue. Relocation assistance will not be required for this project.
