### AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Polk Boulevard Reconstruction from I-235 to University Avenue - Receiving bids, (4-9-19), and Setting date of hearing, (5-6-19). Construction Estimate - \$1,500,000.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project will reconstruct the deteriorated roadway and replace defective sidewalk at isolated locations along Polk Boulevard from north of I-235 to University Avenue.

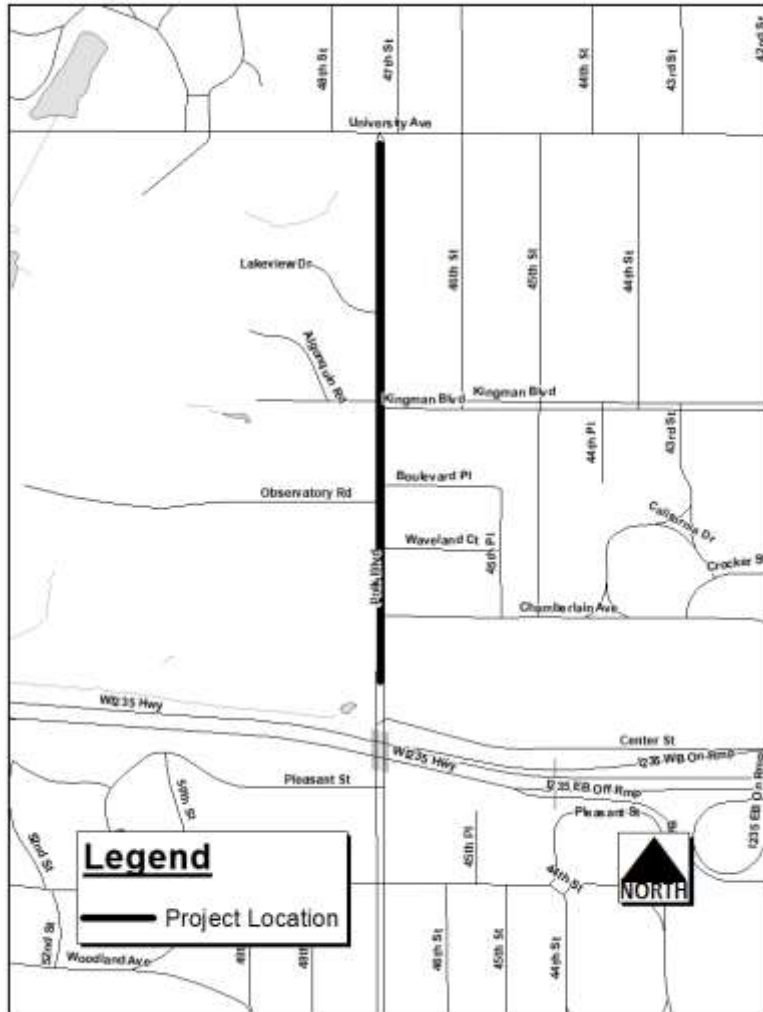
### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$1,500,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Street – 25, Roadway Rehabilitation - Collector, ST217, Gaming Monies, Being: \$1,475,000.00 in Gaming Monies; and the remaining \$25,000 in Storm Water Utility Funds, SM057

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Polk Boulevard Reconstruction from I-235 to University Avenue, 06-2018-019. The improvement includes the reconstruction of roadway pavement with full-depth Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, modified subbase, and subgrade treatment, sidewalk, modular block retaining walls, storm intakes, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 608-145/168, located on Polk Boulevard from north of I-235 to University Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$1,500,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to start late spring or early summer and be completed fall of 2019.
