AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Gray Street Concrete Culvert Rehabilitation: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Proshot Concrete, Inc., Anthony McDougle, President, \$664,250.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Gray Street Concrete Culvert Rehabilitation and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The existing box culvert is approximately 10-foot-wide by 6-foot-tall, and is almost 100 years old. The 550 lineal feet of culvert that needs rehabilitated is in an advanced state of deterioration and is located at the downstream end of the culvert that outlets at S.E. 6th Street and Hartford Avenue. This project provides for the rehabilitation of the last 550 lineal feet of this box culvert due to its advanced state of deterioration. The method of rehab will be a structural lining that will be a less disruptive method for rehabilitating compared to excavating and replacing the existing culvert with new facilities.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$664,250 Construction Contract (\$1,220,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Storm – 4, City-wide Storm Water Utility Projects, SM057, Storm Water Utility Funds

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On February 11, 2019, under Roll Call No. 19-0186, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Gray Street Concrete Culvert Rehabilitation. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Gray Street Concrete Culvert Rehabilitation, 08-2019-001. The improvement includes sewer cleaning, concrete culvert patching, concrete culvert lining, and other related items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Numbers 607-224/227, located near S.E. 6th Street and Hartford Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

 - Front Range Environmental, LLC, McHenry, IL
 - PCi Roads, LLC, St. Michael, MN - Bid not read – Proposal page eight (8) missing
 - Engineering & Construction Innovations, Inc., Oakdale, MN - Bid not read – Proposal page eight (8) missing
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on February 26, 2019.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Proshot Concrete, Inc., Anthony McDougle, President, 4158 Musgrove Drive, Florence, AL, 35630 in the amount of \$664,250, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
