AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on University Avenue Rehabilitation from 56th Street to 48th Street: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Jeffrey A. Chapman, General Manager, \$727,677.05.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the University Avenue Rehabilitation from 56th Street to 48th Street and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will rehabilitate deteriorated roadway pavement on University Avenue from 48th Street to 55th Street. This project includes a shared use trail along the south side of University Avenue and will convert the 4-lane roadway section to a 3-lane section along the corridor.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$727,677.05 Construction Contract (\$835,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Street – 44, University Avenue - 42nd Street to 63rd Street, ST275, Being: \$227,677.05 in G.O. Bonds; the remaining \$500,000 (maximum) in Surface Transportation Block Program Federal-aid Swap Project funds being 80% eligible roadway construction costs under STBG-SWAP-1945(846)—SG-77.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

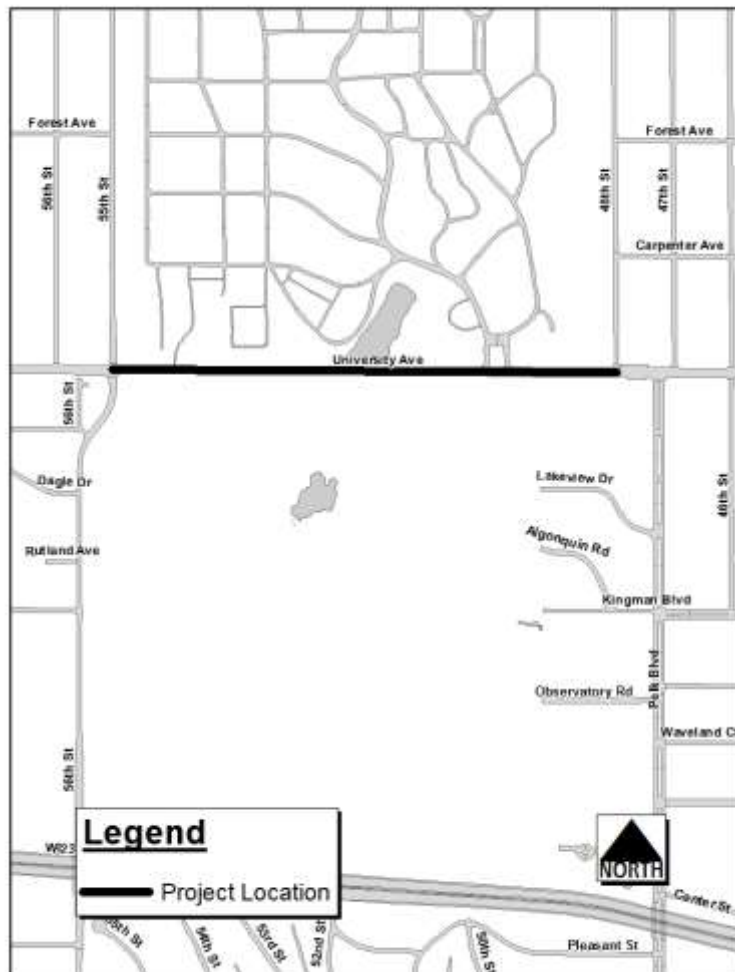
- On January 28, 2019, under Roll Call No. 19-0112, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the University Avenue Rehabilitation from 56th Street to 48th Street. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the University Avenue Rehabilitation from 56th Street to 48th Street, 06-2018-020. The improvement includes pavement scarification, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, modified subbase, subdrain, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) curb and gutter, PCC driveways, pavement removal, grading, PCC trail, storm sewer, traffic control, pavement markings,

restoration, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 600-255/279, located on University Avenue from 48th Street to 55th Street, Des Moines, Iowa.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA
 - OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
 - TK Concrete, Inc., Pella, IA
 - Hawkeye Paving Corporation, Bettendorf, IA
 - Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., Slater, IA

- The bids, in accordance with a previously approved Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement, were received and opened by the IDOT on February 19, 2019.

- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Jeffrey A. Chapman, General Manager, 2401 SE Tones Drive, Suite 13, Ankeny, IA, 50021 in the amount of \$727,677.05, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
