AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 9th and Locust Parking Garage Electrical Improvements: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Price Industrial Electric, Inc., Jeremy Price, President/CFO, \$546,560.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 9th and Locust Parking Garage Electrical Improvements and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the installation of new conduits, circuits, and LED lights for the 9th & Locust Parking Garage. The existing lighting conduits, wiring, and circuits are causing light outages throughout the parking garage and need replacement.

FISCAL IMPACT:



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• On May 6, 2019, under Roll Call No. 19-0695, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 9th and Locust Parking Garage Electrical Improvements. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 9th and Locust Parking Garage Electrical Improvements, 04-2019-015. The improvement includes the removal of the existing lighting system and installation of a new LED lighting system, including electrical wiring and conduit, LED lights, lighting control panels, demolition, patching, and traffic control; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 611-011/028, located at the 801 Locust Street.

- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Price Industrial Electric, Inc., Jeremy Price, President/CFO, 405 North Troy Road, Robins, IA, 52328 in the amount of \$546,560, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
