Town Hall Meetings Nov. 4th for DSM City Budget

WHAT: City Manager Richard A. Clark and city staff will gather public input from Des Moines residents and business owners before they compile City Budget recommendations that will be presented to the City Council. Clark will ask citizens which city services they value most and what ideas they may have to reduce costs in the city budget.

Clark and Finance Director Allen McKinley will host two town hall meetings at the Des Moines Central Library. The town hall meetings will be broadcast “live” from the library on DMTV, Cable Channel 7 on the MediaCom Cable System and a live telephone bank will be set up to allow citizens to call-in their suggestions for the budget; dial 515-283-4100.
