CITY HALL MOVE BEGINS APRIL 7th Check Before You Make the Trek

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DES MOINES, IOWA – Wednesday, March 30, 2016 – Beginning Thursday, April 7th, City staff will begin moving out of the historic City Hall located (400 Robert D. Ray Drive) for 18- 24 months while the building is undergoing maintenance. This work overlaps two other major projects in the area – the Grand Avenue Bridge Over the Des Moines River Replacement and the East 2nd and Grand Parking Garage.

Relocation of these offices will make access to City services easier for our citizens during construction in and around City Hall. During this time, the City Clerk, City Manager’s Office, Engineering, Finance and Legal departments will be relocating to the City Administration Building at 400 E. Court Avenue. The Human Resources department will move across the street from City Hall to the Armory Building 602 Robert D. Ray Drive.

Residents will see familiar faces, offering the same services in different locations. Examples of impacted services include:

Parking tickets

Pet licenses & Dog Park permits

City employment

Meetings with elected officials

Bid openings

Street use applications

Council, boards, and commission meetings will also undergo changes. All meetings that are currently held in City Hall will remain in City Hall through May. Please view dmgov.org/move for new meeting locations.
