RESOLUTION APPROVING NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL REVITALIZATION PROGRAM FAÇADE GRANT FOR \$9,250 TO ASSIST IN RENOVATIONS TO 2706 BEAVER AVENUE, DES MOINES

WHEREAS, University Group, LLC owns the property at 2706 Beaver Avenue, Des Moines represented by Mark, C. Craiger, Member-Manager, 934 45th Street, Des Moines, and Jeffery H. Spence, Member-Manger, 305 47th Street, West Des Moines, (hereinafter referred to as Developer) and have made an application for a Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization Façade Grant in the amount of \$9,250 to assist in the renovations to 2706 Beaver Avenue, Des Moines, and,

WHEREAS, City staff have found the project to be eligible under environmental reviews and program requirements; and,

WHEREAS, the Developer will be responsible for completing renovations to the property of at least \$18,500, plus any additional payments associated with cost overruns for the improvements to the commercial building located at 2706 Beaver Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the Developer has executed the attached Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization Façade Grant Agreement and the City Council finds the form of the grant to be acceptable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

- 1. The Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization Facade Grant is hereby approved.
- 2. The Mayor is authorized and directed to sign the attached document and the City Clerk is authorized to attest to the Mayor's signature and to obtain proper acknowledgment.
