WHEREAS, the Public Works Department Street Maintenance Division requested the Finance Department Procurement Division to issue a blanket purchase order for Crafcoc crack sealant (Roadsaver 221) and detackifier (Detack) pavement maintenance products for use with existing Crafcoc pavement preservation equipment to be purchased during fiscal year 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator has determined that Crafcoc pavement maintenance products are available from Logan Contractors Supply, 4101 106th Street, Urbandale, IA 50322 (Bruce Logan/President), the sole area-wide distributor; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (a)(7) provides for a non-competitive procurement of goods and/or services that are of such a nature that they are the only goods and/or services which will fit and comply with the required use, or are an integral part of a total system so as to be uniquely compatible with existing City need, materials or equipment to be cost-effective; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from CO38PW99/ST102, Street Improvements/Concrete Paving Restoration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City Council hereby accepts and approves the purchase of Crafcoc pavement maintenance products during the fiscal year 2016 from Logan Contractors Supply, at a total estimated annual cost of \$65,000.00.
